

# **Town of Souris By-laws**

## **BY-LAW No. 80-7**

### **BREAKWATER STREET AND PARKSIDE AVENUE**

Pursuant to Sections 83 and 84 of the Town Act, R.S.P.E.I. 1974, Cap T-4, the Town of Souris enacts the following by-law respecting Breakwater Street and Parkside Avenue.

1. All trucks and motor vehicles having a gross weight in excess of 10,000 pounds shall be prohibited from traveling on Parkside Avenue and that portion of Breakwater Street extending from the intersection of Breakwater Street and Parkside Avenue to a point where Breakwater Street is intersected on its south boundary by the entrance to the CTMA Ferry Terminal.
2. Notwithstanding Paragraph 1, service trucks, such as trucks carrying plumbing supplies, oil and gas, dairy products, propane, exceeding a gross weight of 10,000 pounds, shall be permitted on the said streets provided that the owners of such trucks obtain from the Town Clerk a permit, in the form of a sticker free of charge, to be affixed to the windshield of the truck.
3. Any person contravening this bylaw shall be liable to a minimum fine of \$25.00.
