Town of Souris By-laws

BYLAW No. 85-1

REGULATING LOITERING AND BY SETTING A CURFEW FOR MINORS

A by-law respecting the maintenance of order in the Town of Souris by regulating loitering and by setting a curfew for minors.

1. No person shall loiter on or around the steps or entrances of any church, place of worship, hail, public building, place of assembly, store, shop or dwelling or on the roads, streets or sidewalks of the Town.

2. No person under the age of sixteen years shall be permitted upon the streets, sidewalks or roads within the Town after the hour of eleven o'clock p.m. during the period from July 1 to September 1 and after the hour of ten o'clock p.m. during the period September 1 to July 1 of each year unless the said person under the age of sixteen years is accompanied by his parent or guardian.

3. Any person violating the provisions of this by-law shall be liable to a fine not exceeding twenty-five dollars, or in default of payment one day in Jail.
