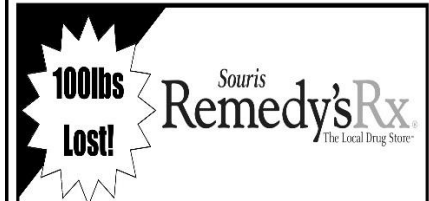

**Make A Plan**

Having an emergency plan will save time and make real situations less stressful. It will help everyone know what to do in case of an emergency.

Once you have a plan, make sure you share it with your family or others who can provide assistance. Keep your plan in an easy-to-find place. Make copies to leave in your vehicle, at work or give to a family member.

Make an Emergency Kit (plastic tote) This kit should be personalized to your household. (medical needs, children, pets & seniors)

**Basic Emergency Kit:**

- \*Water (min. 2 liters/person/day)
- \*Food – non-perishable (replace annually)
- \*Manual can opener
- \*Radio (crank or battery powered) extra batteries
- \*Flashlight (crank or battery powered)
- \*First aid kit
- \*Extra car/house keys
- \*Money (bills/change)
- \*Copy of emergency plan
- \*Medication, Formula, Equipment for disabilities, Pet supplies
- \*Corded Phone (cordless don't work without power)

Note: In the event of the need for a short-term emergency shelter; The **Warming Shelter** is located at The EKSP, Acorn Room.
