INSIDE EXHIBITS

Mandatory: NO CONTESTANTS ALLOWED IN AREA WITH JUDGES.

Entry forms should be filled out by exhibitor and entry tickets affixed to all exhibits.

Entry Forms are available from the Department of Agriculture, Town of Souris Office, The Directors & The Eastern Kings Exhibition Office & Montague ACCESS PEI.

Entry Tickets will be available at the Eastern Kings Office at the Souris Town Hall.

All Exhibits in CLASSES I, II, III, IV, & V must be entered and tagged by 11:00 a.m. September 13th, 2019.

Class Judging starts at 12:30 p.m. September 13th, 2019.

All Exhibits in CLASSES I, II, III, IV, & V must not have previously been entered at the Eastern Kings Exhibition. Any misrepresentation of this regulation will lead to disqualification of the item and forfeiture of the prize monies. Prize payouts will be available the following week.

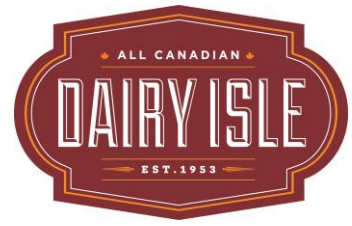
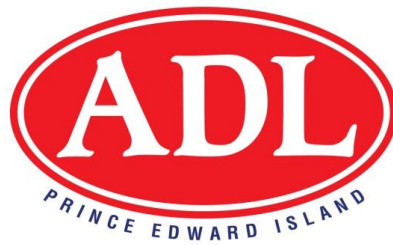
