Islanders can now enter libraries to borrow books, DVDs, museum passes, musical instruments, etc. and access public computers. Curbside service is also available for those not wishing to enter the library.

Public libraries will continue to work closely with the Chief Public Health Office to ensure appropriate measures are in place such as screening, physical distancing and enhanced cleaning to keep staff and Islanders safe. To limit the spread of COVID-19, some library services are not available including:

- public seating and room rentals;
- children's toys, puzzles and games; and
- in-person library programming.

Burning permits are required for all outdoor burning in PEI during fire season - March 15 to November 30 each year.

Permits are available free-of-charge online from Monday to Friday during normal working hours.

- Have the civic address and/or the Property Identification Number(s) on hand for the requested burn location.
- Make sure you accept the disclaimer and acceptance statements stating that you have read and understand the requirements at the end of the form.
