Emergency Measures Operation **Why should we prepare for 72 hours?**

If an emergency happens in your area, it may take emergency workers some time to reach you. Could you look after yourself and your family for three days if an emergency occurred, no services were available and emergency responders couldn't get to you?

Emergencies may be beyond our control, but we can reduce the risk and the impact regardless of what causes the emergency. There are three simple steps everyone can take to become better prepared to face emergencies: Know the risks; Make a plan; Get an emergency kit.

**Please be aware that the reception centre for the Town of Souris and surrounding areas is the upstairs of The Eastern Kings Sportsplex. In the event of an emergency you can call 902-687-2157 to see if the reception room is open. There is a generator to run the facility. When the reception area is open, people will be able to use the washrooms, charge electronic devices, warm up and benefit from the kitchen.

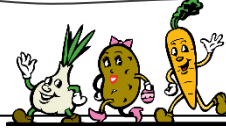
