# F. GREEN AND INCLUSIVE COMMUNITY BUILDINGS PROGRAM. ~ UPGRADES TO Eastern Kings SPORTSPLEX

We were notified that this application for a retrofit to our Sportsplex was denied. A copy of the response is included.

G. Innovation Communities Fund/ACOA (Dog Park, Ballfield Upgrades, Rink Roof, Matthew McLean Bldg Upgrades)

Additional work (*new flooring at MM Bldg.,Bleachers (we ordered 4), 12 Solar Lights, and Storage building at Tennis Courts)* agreed upon by Council at our last meeting has been approved by our funders and has been since completed. Final Claims have been submitted.

\*\*\*While on the call with ACOA for this project they asked us if we could utilize some money they had left in a Hurricane Fiona Recovery Fund (HFRF) to purchase some new equipment for our reception centre. At **<u>zero</u>** cost to us we are able to get 114 new chairs, 60 new tables, a new industrial dishwasher for the kitchen, new coffee/tea urns and a water bottle filling station. These are items that were eligible for this funding AND could be purchased prior to their deadline of March 31, 2024. We were approved for 100% of the cost. \*\*\*
