NOTICE RESIDENTS



The Town of Souris

We want all residents to be aware that if an emergency happens in the community, it may take emergency workers some time to reach them. They should be prepared to take care of themselves and their families for a minimum of 72 hours.

Emergencies can be stressful. However, if people take the time to prepare, they will be better able to cope. There are emergency preparedness guides available at the Souris Town Hall and we are going to make them available in other businesses located in the town.



There are three basic steps to being prepared.

1. Know the risks
2. Make a plan
3. Create an emergency kit. It is so important for people to get to know their neighbors better so that if they ever do need assistance they can reach out to their neighbor. Do a neighbourly buddy check.

The Town of Souris and Souris West's emergency reception centre is the upstairs of the Eastern Kings Sportsplex, 203 Veterans Highway. There will be signs posted outside the centre (weather permitting) to let the public know the centre is open. It is important that people contact their municipality to find out if the centre is open and confirm the hours of operation.
