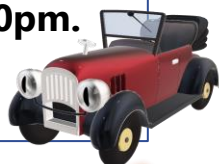

Scammers try new methods to trick you all the time. But if you know the signs to look for, you may avoid becoming a victim.



5 Signs of a Scam

If you spot any of these tactics, stop and walk away. You're probably being scammed.

1.They contacted you

You don't know if they are whom they say they are. And remember, email addresses and caller ID information can be faked.

2.They dangle bait—usually money

Let's face it: People simply don't give away large sums of money easily. If someone dangles bait in front of you—a big prize, a shopping spree, an easy loan — for nothing, they're probably lying.

3.They want your personal

information. Don't give it away quickly or easily, especially to

someone you don't know. **4.You have**

to pay them first. **5.If you're about to**

wire money or send gift cards to someone in order to receive a prize

or pay off a debt collector that contacts you ... **STOP!** This may be a

scammer trying to take your money. If you feel you're the subject of a

scam, simply cut off communication and then file a complaint with RCMP.
