Free tax-help clinics will be available to Island residents with modest-to-no income and a simple tax situation who need assistance to complete their tax and benefit return.

Filing an annual income tax return is the key to accessing qualifying benefits like the Canada child benefit, Canada workers benefit and the GST/HST credit. Clientele: Indigenous, newcomers, persons with disabilities, residents/patients, seniors, social assistance recipients, students, and youth.
