MINUTES

Regular Monthly Meeting MONDAY, June 11, 2018 @ 7:00pm

Council met informally prior to meeting to discuss the request to donate land. Issue was carried into public meeting for formal discussion. No motions were made.

A. Call the regular monthly meeting of Council to Order 7:OOPM

- K. Application from Mike Clinton to operate a Bed & Breakfast in his home at 50 Main Street. MOTION by C. Peters and seconded by C. MacDonald to approve application to operate a Bed & Breakfast by Mike Clinton of 50 Main Street. Proposal is for 1 bedroom only. Adequate parking is available. All other Provincial regulations must be met. All in favour. Motion carried.
- L. Review and recommendation required to proceed with process to Amend our Unsightly Premises By Law #2004-07 that was prepared by our lawyer John Hennessey. Copy of amendment attached. In order to amend we are required to provide public notification as well as two readings at two separate meetings.
 - **MOTION** by C. Thibodeau and seconded by C. Cheverie that CAO proceed with necessary public notification process in order to amend By Law #2004-07. All in favour. Motion carried.
- M. CAO would like permission to begin Development Bylaw & Official Plan review process by looking into possible funding sources, RFP preparation, etc. As per section 15.1 of the PEI Planning Act we are required to review and update our Development Bylaws and Official Plan every 5 years. We are currently past the 5 year mark. Now that the new Municipal Government Act and Planning Act are complete or near complete we need to be in compliance.

MOTION by C. Thibodeau and seconded by C. Dunphy to proceed with this process. All in favour. Motion carried.

New Business, Correspondence, Requests and/or Additions:

N. Patching and Paving Tender. Two bids were received. Chapman Bros. Construction \$41,568.28 Island Construction \$47,453.60. It was recommended by Streets Chairperson C. MacDonald to award the tender to the lowest bidder Chapman Bros. Construction conditional that the work be completed by deadline in bid form. Work has already commenced.

MOTION by C. MacDonald and seconded by C. Peters to award this tender to Chapman Bros. Const. for \$41,568.28. All in favour. Motion carried.

Peters that the Town consider donating PID#899187 with access to Anniversary Ave to David and Wendy McQuaid for the purposes of developing four 5 unit senior friendly accessible and affordable houses. As required a public meeting will need to be held in order to donate or sell land under market value. Also, this land would need to be rezoned from Open Space to Multi family Residential. This will also be brought to public meeting for review. All those living within close proximity of the land will be notified by mail as well as an Ad in Guardian to notify all residents of the Town. All in favour. Motion carried.
