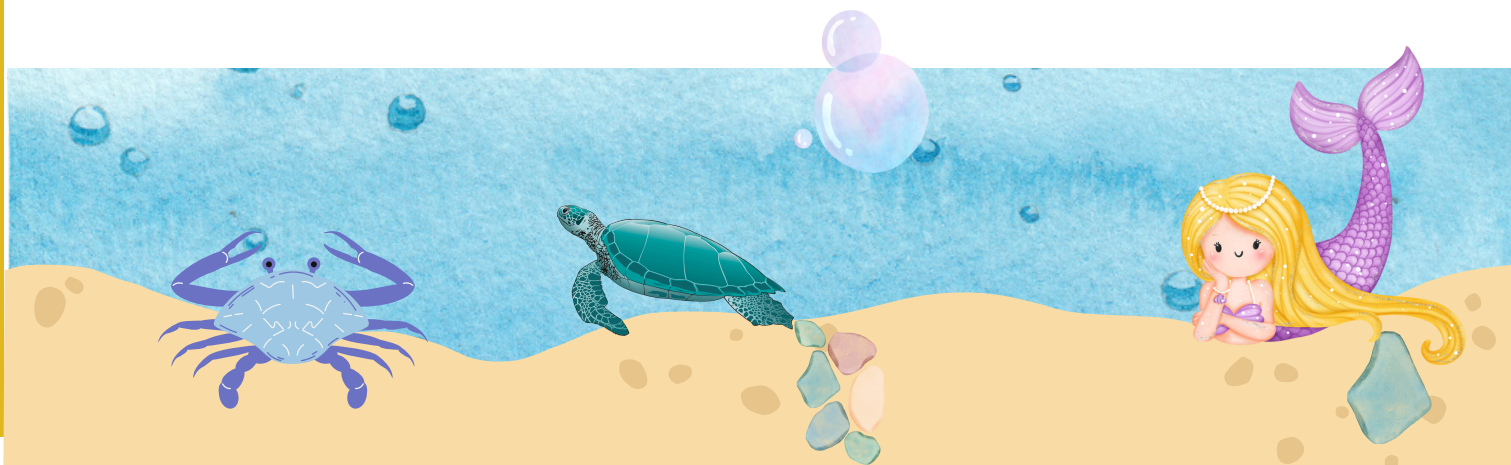

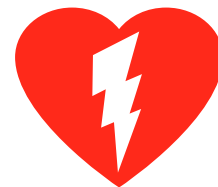

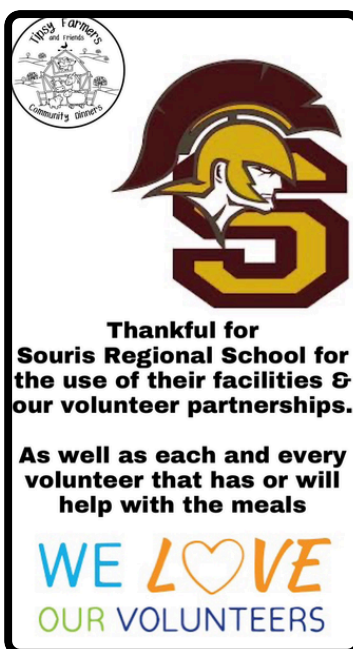

## BURNING PERMITS

If you require a burning permit, you must apply with the Province, the Town of Souris does not issue burning permits for any area of the municipality.

The municipal bylaws for burning are located on the Town of Souris website.

In the Town of Souris, Prince Edward Island, burning regulations are outlined in **By-law No. 85-4: Garbage Burning**. This by-law prohibits individuals from burning or incinerating grass or garbage on any property—commercial, residential, or recreational—without prior written consent from the Town Council and approval from the Fire Chief.

The Fire Chief determines the appropriate type of incinerator to be used for such activities.

Violations of this by-law result in fines: \$50 for the first offence and \$100 for each subsequent offence.

Additionally, during the **wildfire season (March 15 to November 15)**, provincial regulations require checking daily burning restrictions before any outdoor burning. You can check current restrictions or call 1-800-237-5053.

### **Burning permits are not required for Category 1 fires.**

Category 1 fire specifications:

Piles no larger than three metres in diameter,

Piles no more than two metres high,

Multiple piles must be at least 10 metres apart from each other,

No more than two piles burning at one time,

Burning of tree limbs, leaves, brush or cut grass is permitted,

Includes campfires\* except in licensed private, municipal, and provincial campgrounds, and **Fire must be attended at all times.**

\*Campfires are any open fires\*\* that burn no larger than 0.5 metres in diameter and are intended for recreation (and not for survival).

\*\*Open fires are any fires not in an enclosed CSA approved appliance (e.g. propane or charcoal fueled appliances such as BBQs, propane or natural gas fire bowls, and Coleman-style camp stoves).

Chimneys are considered open fires.

### Clothing Dryer Tips

Turn off dryer when you leave home or go to bed.

Have all dryers installed by a professional.

Dryer should be grounded.

Ensure that proper outlet and plug are used on the dryer.

Clean lint filter out after every dryer load and clean the lint around the drum.

Keep the area around the dryer free of combustibles.

Ensure the air exhaust vent pipe is clear and the outdoor vent flap will open and not be blocked or covered by snow.

If cloths have been in contact with gasoline, paint thinner or substances like this lay the cloths outside to dry, wash and then dry in dryer.

Install a smoke alarm outside the dryer room.

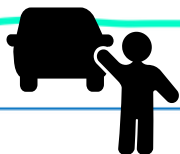
