### **SAFE HOME INSTRUCTIONS**



Make sure you have a working smoke alarm and carbon monoxide detector installed on each level of your home. It is recommended that you also install a smoke detector in every bedroom. You should also have a well-stocked first aid kit to treat minor injuries. If you live in an apartment, know where the fire alarms and at least two emergency exits are located. Remember the reception centre (a place, often used during emergencies where people can gather, receive services, and potentially find temporary accommodation or assistance.)

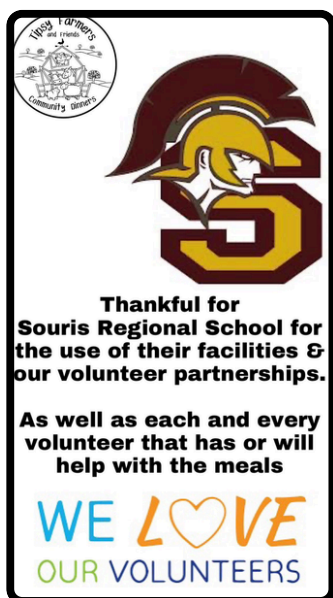

## BURNING PERMITS

If you require a burning permit, you must apply with the Province, the Town of Souris does not issue burning permits for any area of the municipality.

The municipal bylaws for burning are located on the Town of Souris website.

In the Town of Souris, Prince Edward Island, burning regulations are outlined in **By-law No. 85-4: Garbage Burning**. This by-law prohibits individuals from burning or incinerating grass or garbage on any property—commercial, residential, or recreational—without prior written consent from the Town Council and approval from the Fire Chief.

The Fire Chief determines the appropriate type of incinerator to be used for such activities.

Violations of this by-law result in fines: \$50 for the first offence and \$100 for each subsequent offence.

**\*\*Additionally, during the wildfire season (March 15 to November 15),** provincial regulations require checking daily burning restrictions before any outdoor burning. You can check current restrictions or call 1-800-237-5053.

### **Burning permits are not required for Category 1 fires.**

Category 1 fire specifications:

Piles no larger than three metres in diameter,

Piles no more than two metres high,

Multiple piles must be at least 10 metres apart from each other,

No more than two piles burning at one time,

Burning of tree limbs, leaves, brush or cut grass is permitted,

Includes campfires\* except in licensed private, municipal, and provincial campgrounds, and **Fire must be attended at all times.**

\*Campfires are any open fires\*\* that burn no larger than 0.5 metres in diameter and are intended for recreation (and not for survival).

\*\*Open fires are any fires not in an enclosed CSA approved appliance (e.g. propane or charcoal fueled appliances such as BBQs, propane or natural gas fire bowls, and Coleman-style camp stoves).

Chimneys are considered open fires.

The Matthew and McLean building was originally constructed in 1869 in order  
to house the then newly formed Matthew and McLean company. Today the  
building houses a historical museum with artifacts related to their general

## A Note From the **RCMP**:

### Keep Our Roads Safe – Say No to Impaired Driving

Impaired driving remains a serious threat to the safety of our community. Every time someone gets behind the wheel under the influence of alcohol or drugs, they put lives at risk – including their own.

On Prince Edward Island, impaired driving continues to be one of the top three leading factors in fatal collisions. This sobering reality underscores the importance of making smart, responsible choices before getting behind the wheel.

Last year alone, the RCMP stopped approximately 230 impaired drivers across the Island. Of these, 140 were under the influence of alcohol, while 90 were impaired by drugs. These numbers are more than just statistics – they represent hundreds of dangerous situations that could have ended in tragedy.

What's encouraging, however, is that 82 of these arrests were made thanks to tips from the public. That means community members like you are playing a crucial role in helping law enforcement keep our roads safer. If you see a suspected impaired driver, don't hesitate – call 911 immediately. Your call could prevent a crash and potentially save lives.

Driving impaired is not just illegal – it's completely preventable. Whether it's arranging for a designated driver, taking a cab, or staying over, there are always better options than risking lives by driving under the influence. Let's work together to protect all Islanders. By staying alert and making responsible choices, we can help ensure that everyone gets home safely. Remember: impaired driving is never worth the risk – and reporting it could make all the difference.

### **Properly use and store gasoline**

- Use gasoline only as motor fuel, never as a cleaner or to break down grease.
- Only store gasoline in a container that is sold for that purpose and never bring it indoors, even in small amounts.
- Never store gasoline containers in a basement or in the occupied space of a building.
- Keep them in a detached garage or an outdoor shed.
- Make sure the container is tightly capped when not in use.

## THE TOWN OF SOURIS DOG LICENSING PROGRAM



runs from June 1 to May 31.

Residents are required to annually register their dogs through this program in person at the Souris Town Hall.

We will need your name, address, phone number, email, the name of your dog(s), the color of the dog(s), the breed, male or female and whether they are spayed or neutered.

Dog tags are \$5 for spayed/neutered dogs and \$10 for non-spayed or non-neutered dogs



The Town of Souris enforces its animal control regulations through the Companion Animal Control By-law 2004-05. This by-law mandates that all dogs residing within the town must be registered and wear a valid dog tag. These tags are renewable annually and are essential for ensuring that lost pets can be promptly identified and returned to their owners

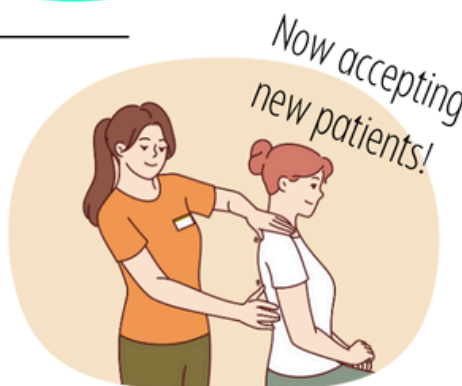
