H. Upgrades, Renovation to Eastern Kings Sportsplex

- Sable Arc/CBCL contacted to proceed with plan for renovation at EK Sportsplex as previously proposed. To include bowling lane space/gym/acorn room.

Letters of support were received from Souris Lions Club, Silver Threads Seniors Club and Colville Bay Manor. The application was submitted prior to July 14th deadline. Response is not expected for several months.

As per August Meeting the Town has signed an agreement to develop Town Promotion on this App. C. Mitsuk and C. Outhouse have offered to help gather information.

New Fire Hall Update & Next Steps • Following a recent conversation with our mayor MP MacDonald has indicated a funding portal through the Federal Government is expected to be available in the coming weeks. • Council to discuss if another municipal service could be included in the plan for a new Fire Hall.

Council met June 15th to discuss further. It was determined that services required for Emergency Measures Operations would be a good fit with a new Fire Hall. CAO has asked CBCL to update the costing provided to a Class “C” estimate as required by the federal funding program.

Water Tank Restoration – CCBF

➤ Phase I has been awarded to Chapman Bros. Const. This will include the water bypass line installation and fencing. Project completed. Awaiting final assessment of project completion from engineers.

➤ Phase II has gone tender with a closing date of **August 20, 2026** To include the actual restoration of the water tank.

- Only one bid was received.
- CBCL to review and report to Council.

CHIF Canada Housing Infrastructure Funding

Our Funding application was approved for a proposed new subdivision. Official announcement of this funding was made July 2, 2026. Mayor and CAO have signed the funding agreement.

- Next steps will involve design of the subdivision to be reviewed and approved by Planning Advisory Board and Town Council.
- Environmental requirements and Duty to consult steps have been initiated.
- A development of a legal agreement between developers and the Town to address financial responsibilities is being drafted.
- A virtual meeting took place with developers, CBCL and Town CAO, on July 22nd to discuss project logistics.
- An RFP has been issued for engineering/consulting services for the design of the subdivision as required in our CHIF Funding agreement. Closing date is September 15, 2026.

Event Grounds at 20 Lea Crane Boulevard

- New Signage has been posted.
- Exhibition has done more work including a new Horse Pull/Tug-of-War pad and new fencing. JEG Earthworks generously donated their time and equipment to complete the work.
- Town Council made a motion at August 2026 meeting to plan to have Canada Day 2027 at the Event Grounds.

TRAFFIC CONCERNS

Belle Ave/Main Street Intersection and other traffic concerns.

- CTMA Ferry Intersection remains a concern
- Cement barriers with flower boxes were placed in front of 120 Main to clearly identify this space as no parking.
- No Parking signs have been posted along east side of Belle Ave.
- Parking signs have been posted at both entrances to public parking lot at 95 Main Street, along with better lighting.
- No Parking signs have been posted near the entrance to the Fitness Centre.
- Addition of crosswalks to Main Street, relocation of Souris River Rd/Chapel Ave crosswalk
- Upgrades to various sidewalks, patching, paving.

Agreement between Town of Souris & Souris Minor Baseball (draft shared at May meeting) and Souris Lamplighters Soccer to be shared with organizations for discussion purposes. The intent of the agreements would be to clearly define who is responsible for things. Eg. Maintenance, grass cutting, dugouts, etc. Councillor Outhouse to discuss with applicable organization representatives.

Matthew & McLean building Council did a walk-through May 19, 2026. Proposed finishing a current unfinished space on the second floor above the Evergreen.

CAO has asked David MacAulay if he could prepare a detailed scope of work to request quotes. Nothing further to report.
